MISSION: The most advanced umpire training camp for non-professional umpires in the country – this is a 7-day no holds barred upper level umpire camp geared to teaching the skills required for NCAA Conference level games.

Program: First class begins Sunday at 6:00 pm and the last class ends at 3:00 pm on Saturday.

Daily instruction includes comprehensive classroom discussion of mechanics and techniques, NCAA Rules and CAA Mechanics, The Strike Zone, Handling Situations, Communication, Philosophy of Plate and Base Work, Field Work and Drills. Plus, daily actual live game assignments with evaluations of on-field performance.

All students will be grouped in accordance with their umpire experience and previous camp experience. *All registrations are subject to approval.*

Tuition includes 6-night double occupancy, class materials, camp t-shirt, continental breakfast and box lunches and drinks.

Instructors: Our staff is comprised of NCAA Coordinators and some of the top Professional and Collegiate Umpires, who are dedicated in sharing the skills and techniques that have made them successful at the highest levels of the game.

Accommodations: Camp tuition will cover your rooms from Sunday at 3:00 pm to 12:00 pm (noon) on Saturday. Camp hotel is located 10 minutes from the training field. Hotel has an on-site classroom, continental breakfast, swimming pool, high speed wireless Internet, a fitness room, and TV.

Field, Cage, and Game Sites: Training is conducted at numerous sites in Central Florida, including; UCF, Stetson University, Rollins College, Bethune-Cookman College, Seminole State College, and Lake Sumpter Community College.

Transportation: Students can drive/car pool with the benefit of having their own transportation in Florida. About half of the students elect to fly. The most convenient and economical flights will be through Orlando Airport. The airport is only 15 miles from the hotel.
